Before joining PANNA in 1996, Margaret spent most of nine years in Central America, teaching and conducting research in tropical agricultural ecology. She worked with university colleagues and NGOs to improve productivity of low-input ecologically sound agricultural methods. Margaret has published her work (in both Spanish and English) in professional and popular/educational journals. Since the early 1980s, she has worked in support of farm worker rights and has been a member of New World Agriculture and Ecology Group. At PANNA, Margaret's current work focuses on farmworker health and safety, pesticide biomonitoring, and linking the pesticide reform movement with that of sustainable food and farming. Margaret is PANNA's Steering Committee representative for the statewide coalition Californians for Pesticide Reform.
